Participants discussed recent administrative changes within the Greek Ministry responsible for migration and child protection. [REDACTED]

A significant segment of the dialogue covered [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Similar experiences in other European countries, particularly Italy, were referenced to emphasize the broader European dimension of the issue.

[REDACTED] underlined, that the challenging conditions on Samos attracted significant scrutiny from NGOs and some Swiss media. It was mentioned that Swiss media outlets questioned the overcrowding, sanitation deficits, incidents of violence, and allegations of systemic deficiencies and excessive policing. Such attention prompted questions directed at Swiss authorities regarding Switzerland's involvement as a financial supporter of projects such as the safe area project. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] In response, [REDACTED] explicitly communicated Switzerland's understanding for the difficult migratory situation, but underlined the importance of discussing difficult issues when they arise. He further confirmed awareness of the complex operational realities on the ground. SHB clarified that, despite the potential critical media coverage within Switzerland, these challenges will be looked at closely, but do not affect the support of the safe area project. [REDACTED]

While cautiously optimistic about the new minister's proactive approach potentially mitigating procedural bottlenecks, [REDACTED] emphasized the necessity of formal written communication for confirming significant project adjustments or funding reallocations to ensure clarity and transparency. Concluding the discussion, participants outlined immediate, medium-term, and strategic priorities for continued cooperation. Immediate efforts focused on bridging funding gaps to prevent interruptions in child protection services, followed by medium-term objectives of swiftly finalizing and operationalizing the new cooperation agreement.
